SUPPORTING HEALTH SYSTEMS STRENGTHENING

Cancer patients are at the core of C/Can's work. Through the C/Can process, cities are supported to develop solutions, policies and processes that will simultaneously improve the lives of cancer patients today and strengthen health systems for cancer care as a whole.

Core areas¹:

01 Service Delivery C/Can supports the development of Quality Assurance Programmes, treatment guidelines and protocols to ensure the standardisation of quality cancer care.

U∠ Health Workforce C/Can helps build the capacity of healthcare professionals across the spectrum of cancer diagnosis, treatment and care.

しろ Health nformation Together with city stakeholders, C/Can generates a local evidence-base, and contributes to strengthening cancer registries and laboratory information management systems.

04 Medical Technologies C/Can efforts include supporting the development of city-wide radiotherapy plans, national essential medicines lists for cancer care, and scale-up of innovative digital solutions.

05 Health Financing

C/Can contributes to understanding the health financing landscape and helps communicate the demand for services to drive investment.

06 Leadership and Governance C/Can connects, activates and builds the capacity of key stakeholders and decision makers on the ground and fosters an enabling policy environmentfor strengthening cancer care systems.

EVIDENCE-BASED DECISION MAKING


By ensuring that proposed solutions are data-driven, C/Can drives investments based on the real needs of the people served and ensures that impact and value are maximised across the healthcare system.
